Dear Parishioners, dear friends,

The beginning of St Luke's Gospel sets the scene today. After the beginning of the gospel we fast forward to Jesus' moment in the synagogue. Here Our Lord reads from the scriptures and all eyes are fixed on Him.

The new lectionary has given us a chance to revisit the immense value of the Word of God proclaimed, especially in the celebration of the sacred liturgy. At Sunday Mass we hear from the gospels and this year - C - from the Gospel according to St Luke. The Old Testament reading often prepares us for the gospel with some connection in terms of theme or content. The second reading stands alone and is invariably from the letters of St Paul. Alleluia is sung before the gospel (except during Lent) and a psalm is recited between the first two readings.

We are use to the familiar structure of the readings at Mass. Often they are moving, sometimes thoughtful, always God wishes to speak to us through His Holy Word.

The important considerations for us as the Lord's faithful, assembled for the celebration of Mass, is that our hearts should be open to listen. On a practical level this is assisted by the effective proclamation of the Word. We are surely all so grateful to those who read the scriptures at Mass and help their meaning to unfold by their own engagement and preparation. Reading sacred scripture with this sense is a really important aspect of the celebration of Mass. If you would like to join the readers let me know.

New missals are now necessary for the new translation. This is especially useful for the psalm and its response between the verses; there is nothing wrong with simply listening to the scriptures as they are read. I encourage you to buy a Sunday missal in the new translation, subscribe to *Magnificat* or use one of the useful phone aps such as *Universalis*. We will arrange for the purchase of some missal for those who would like to borrow one for Sunday Mass.

May the Lord be in our hearts and in our minds that we may both proclaim and listen to His Holy Word.

Diocesan Pastoral Plan and the Weybridge Deanery

Bishop Richard shared his Pastoral Plan and vision for our diocese in January 2024. In time our deanery will become a single 'parish of communities.' A Steering Group was set up, with Canon Chris Spain of Egham as the Moderator, and is now meeting regularly to discern ways forward. The group, consisting of clergy and lay people, is looking at how we embed the principles and vision of the Pastoral Plan, recognising that the roles of clergy will evolve, also how we provide support for parish communities and mission.
