Our School



There are pro formas called 'Recording Forms for Safeguarding Concerns' in the staffroom and the school office. Do NOT conduct your own investigation. If your concerns relate to the actions or behaviour of a member of staff (which could suggest that she/he is unsuitable to work with children) then you should report this to Mrs Burnham who will undertake the appropriate actions.
